Jaripeo Espectacular - August 28 / 2:00 PM Enjoy bull riding, Ixtapa dancing, and horses during this ultimate family fun event.

Guarantee event entry with a Fast Pass

*Pavilion events are free with your Fair Admission but they are first-come, first-served, while



space lasts. Visitors can guarantee entry to any Pavilion event by purchasing a \$5 <u>Fast Pass</u> for that day. Fast passes also grant early access to the Pavilion, and on August 26 & 27 Fast Pass holders can dance on the dirt floor of the Pavilion and access a private bar during the Ned LeDoux and Maddie & Tae concerts. Fast Passes do not include Fair Admission.

Rockstar parking lot

<u>Parky Like a Rockstar</u> in our special Rockstar Parking lot across from our new Green Gate. Once you park, you'll just walk right across the street to the new private Green Gate leading you into Homegrown Oregon in the beautiful Green Acres Landscape Plaza. Parky Like a Rockstar passes do not include Fair Admission.
