Reserved tickets: start at \$50 and include free Fair admission

VIPPlus Suite Seats tickets: cost \$125, and include free Fair admission, plus a souvenir lanyard, priority entrance, special food service, access to a VIP beverage bar, and a reserved seat in the premium center section

Free tickets: a limited selection of free seats are available for each show with paid Fair admission on a first-come, first-served basis, while space lasts

Showtimes: Doors open at 6:30 p.m. and shows begin at 7:30 p.m., except for Chris Janson, whose doors open at 3:30 p.m. and the show begins at 4:30 p.m.
