Fair Traditions for the Whole Family

<u>Livestock</u>: Friendly yet fierce competition defines open class livestock, where 4-H and FFA exhibitors vie for ribbons, premiums, and bragging rights. The Multi Breed Oregon State Fair <u>Horse Show</u> begins August 28, featuring diverse horse breeds across 8 days. Visit the Forester Livestock Pavilion to say hello to mamma pig and her piglets, and the rare <u>Valais Blacknose</u> sheep, making their Fair debut. The 4-H/FFA Barn hosts new live demos for Sheep Shearing, <u>Needle Felting</u>, and <u>Welt Felt</u>. The <u>Historic Poultry Building</u> is back this year. Learn about the renovations that are in store for this iconic 1921 building.

<u>Creative Living</u> Discover displays, exhibits, demonstrations, and competitions that cover the full spectrum of life in Oregon. Returning favorites include Oregon Authors, Military Uniforms (VFW 661-Uniforms), Oregon Ag in the classroom, and Remote-Controlled vehicles. New this year: CANstruction - teams will build a map of Oregon out of donated canned food to benefit the Marion Polk Food Share. Sunny's bake-off will feature doll cakes inspired by a movie that is very popular in theatres right now. A Fiber Arts Dye Competition, a certified Quilts judge (the only one in Oregon), and STEM with Oregon State University Biophysics.

<u>September 4</u>: Heroes Day! Military, First Responders, Teachers, and their families receive free admission as a gesture of gratitude. Identification is not required.
